THERE IS NO RELIABLE VIDEO-FILTERING SOLUTION FOR YOUTUBE.

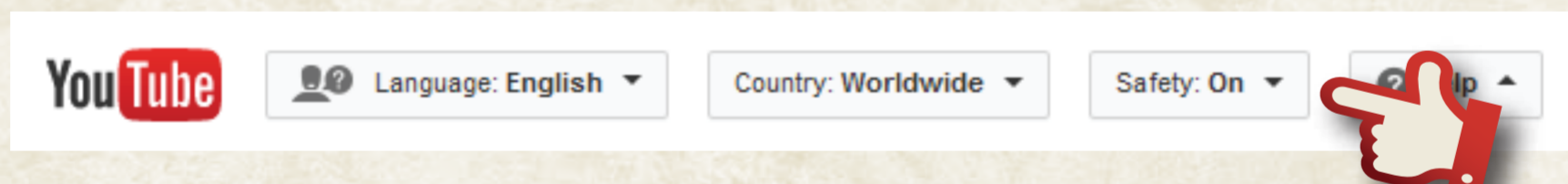
-  You are about 4 degrees of separation (clicks) from inappropriate content on YouTube.

The solution:

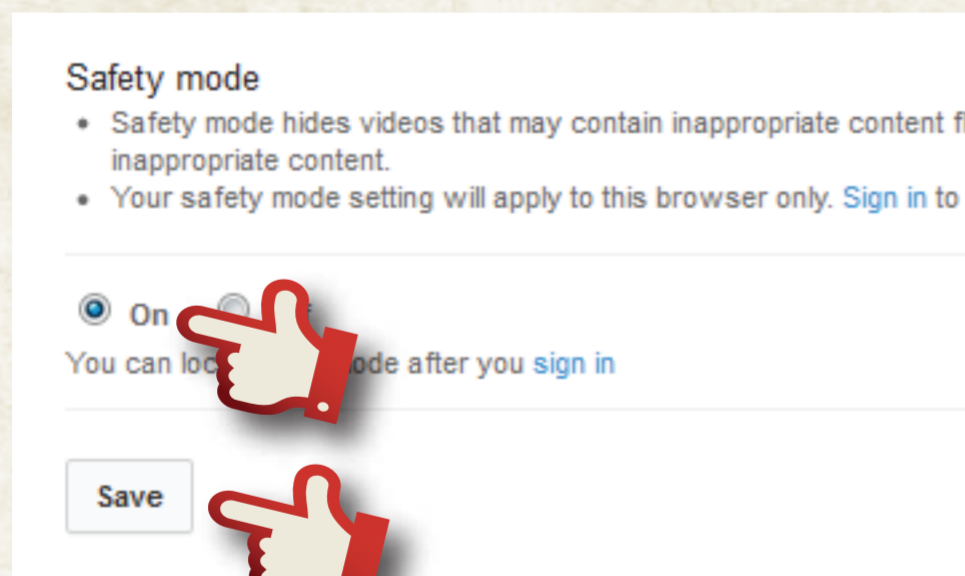



TURN ON AND LOCK YOUTUBE SAFETY MODE!

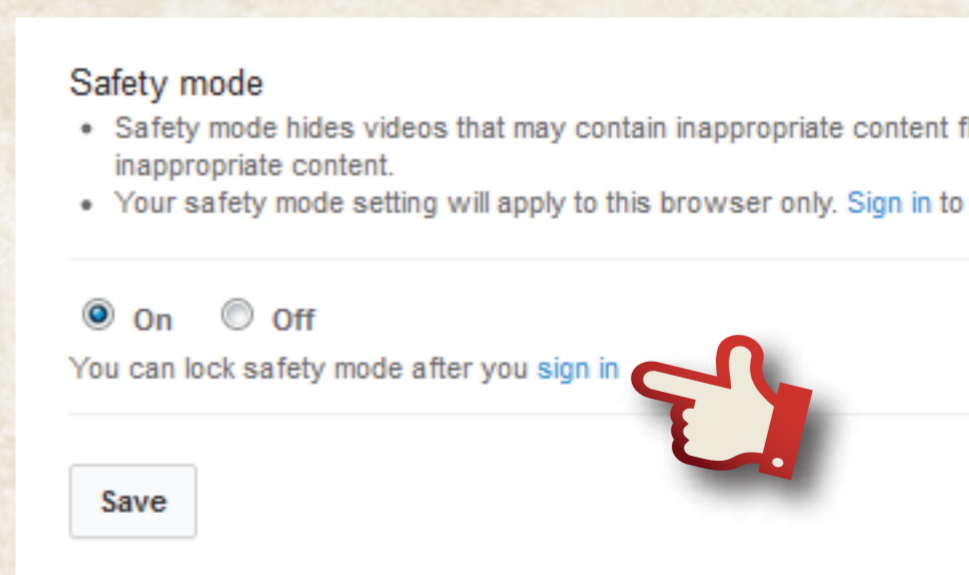
-  Scroll to the bottom of any YouTube page and click the "Safety" button.




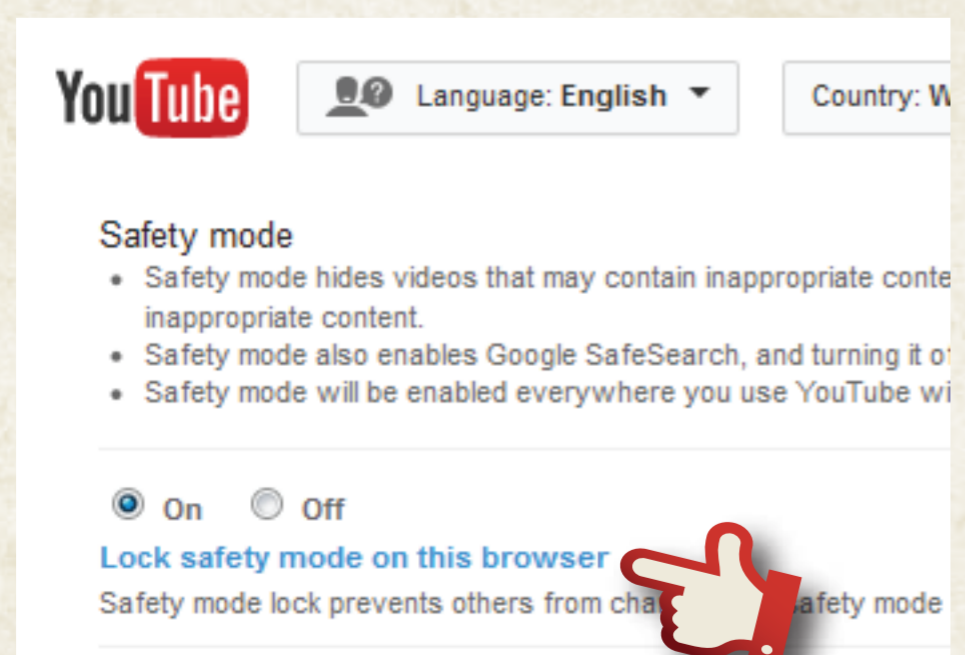
-  Set Safety Mode to "on" and click "Save."




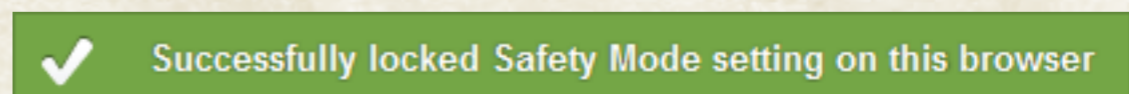
-  To lock the setting for your browser, sign in to your Google account by clicking "sign in." Enter your Google username and password.



-  Return to the Safety Mode panel by clicking the "Safety Button" again, then click "Lock safety mode on this browser." You may need to re-enter your Google password.



-  You should now see this message:



You can disable Safety Mode again by logging in and clicking "Unlock safety mode on this browser." You may have to re-enter your Google password.
